Management Specialist PRODAIRY, Cornell University


Dr. Lynch is part of Cornell University's PRO-DAIRY Program. Dr. Lynch grew up in Elmira, New York. He completed his undergraduate work at Rochester Institute of Technology and received

his veterinary degree from Tufts University. School of Veterinary Medicine in 1997. Dr. Lynch worked in private practice for 8 years in Southeast Pennsylvania where his responsibilities included all large animal species with an emphasis on dairy cattle. Dr. Lynch also was a partner in his practice for 4 years. In 2007, Dr. Lynch completed the Dairy Production Medicine Certificate course at Penn State University. Dr. Lynch joined Pfizer's Cattle Veterinary Operations team in 2005. which later became Zoetis, and provided dairy technical support for the Northeastern US. Areas of interest include transition cow health, milk quality, reproduction, replacement management, genomics, housing, lameness prevention, immunology, obstetrics and neonatal care.
